CHAPTER XXIII.

A further SUPPLEMENT to the act entitled "An act to provide for the erection of a House for the employment and support of the poor in the county of York."

WHEREAS the act to which this is a supplement does not provide for the adjustment of claims which existed at the time it was passed and came into operation: Therefore,

SECTION I. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That all claims and demands existing at the passing or coming into operation of the act to which this is supplementary, shall have the same force and effect, and be prosecuted in the same manner as if that act had not been passed; and upon final adjustment of such claims and demands, if need be, it shall be the duty of the supervisors of the highways of the borough or townships against which the said claims or demands are established, to collect the same by a tax on the said borough or townships, and pay the same in discharge of the said claims and demands; and that it shall be the duty of the persons appointed in the said borough or townships, to settle the accounts of the supervisors of the highways, to settle the accounts of the overseers of the poor of said borough, and their respective townships.

Of prosecuting and paying demands, existing at the coming into operation of the original act.
