

settle and adjust all accounts which may be exhibited by any person or persons legally employed in carrying this act into effect, and all expences necessarily attending the same shall be paid by the aforesaid commissioners out of the nett proceeds of the said lottery.

Empowered to adjust and pay all lawful debts incurred under this act.

SECT. IV. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That all prizes not demanded within twelve months after the publication as aforesaid, shall be considered as relinquished for the benefit of the said lottery.

Within what time prizes are to be demanded, &c.

CHAPTER CXV.

*An ACT for extending an act, entitled "An act, regulating and continuing the distribution of Donation Lands."*

SECTION I. *BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the act, entitled "An act regulating and continuing the distribution of donation lands," passed the twenty-fifth day of March, one thousand eight hundred and five, be, and the same is hereby extended, and all matters and things therein contained, (the limitation clause only excepted), shall be and continue in force until the first day of April, one thousand eight hundred and eight.

The act for the distribution of donation lands continued till April 1st, 1808.
