#### CHAPTER XIV.

#### CHAPTER XV.

A SUPPLEMENT to an act, entitled “*An act to regulate the fisheries in the river Delaware, and its branches, and for other purposes.*”

WHEREAS by an act of assembly of this commonwealth, passed on the eighth day of February, in the year of our Lord, one thousand eight hundred and four, entitled “*An act to regulate the fisheries in the river Delaware and its branches, and for other purposes,*” and in the twelfth section thereof, it is enacted and declared, that “*so soon as the legislature of New-Jersey, shall have enacted a law containing provisions similar to those herein before enacted, that then this act shall, and is hereby declared to be in full force and effect,*” and whereas the legislature of the state of New-Jersey, by an act passed on the twenty-sixth day of November, in the year of our Lord, one thousand eight
