CHAPTER CIII.

An ACT changing the terms for holding the courts in the cir-cuit of the sixth district, it being supplementary to an act, entitled "Areact to alter the Judiciary System of this Commonwealth."

Section I. BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That from and after the publication of this act, the arrangement of the terms in the circuit of the sixth district, shall be fixed in the following manner, to wit: That after the next September term to be held under the authority of the act, entitled "An act to alter the judiciary system of this commonwealth," passed the twenty-fourth day of February, one thou-

sand eight hundred and six, that instead of commencing the circuit of the said district, at the town of Butler, in the county of Butler, on the first Mondays in December, March, June, and September, the circuit of the sixth district shall after the said September term be held, and commence at the town of Franklin, in the county of Venango, on the first Mondays in November, February, May and August; in the county of Butler, on the second Mondays of the same months; in the county of Mercer on the third Mondays of the same months; in the county of Crawford on the fourth Mondays of the same months; and in the county of Eric on the Mondays succeeding the commencement of the courts in the county of Crawford.
