make, seal, and deliver good and sufficient title or titles for the same, to the purchaser or purchasers, and to pay the nett proceeds of such sales into the county treasury, to be applied towards defraying the expenses of said public buildings, erected, or to be erected, as aforesaid, or to other county purposes.

SECT. VIII. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, That so much of the existing laws of this commonwealth as are

altered by this act be, and the same is hereby repealed.

CHAPTER XXXVII.

A SUPPLEMENT to an act, entitled "An act authorizing the president, adjuntas and members of the Hebrew congregation, of the city of Philadelphia, to raise by way of lottery, a sum of money for the repairs of their Synagogue and burial place, and for other purposes of relief.

SECT. I. BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That Martin Dubs, Samuel Israel and Aaron Levy, be, New comand they are hereby appointed commissioners, in the place or missioners stead of Samuel Meeker, Jacob Sperry, and Moses Nathans, appointed who have declined the duties to which they were appointed by the act entitled as expressed in the title of this act, which is a supplement thereto, and the said Martin Dubs, Samuel Israel, and Aaron Levy, are authorized, empowered and required to Their powdo and perform all the duties necessary for carrying into effect ers. and operation the said law subject to the same rules and regulations contained therein.

SECT. II. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,
That should any vacancy happen in the board of commissioners How vacanaforesaid, or should or either of them refuse to take upon them cies are to be,
the duties enjoined, then, and in such case the remaining comsupplied,
missioners, with the elders of the congregation, for the time
being, shall be authorized and empowered to fill up any such
vacancy.
