

first day of March, one thousand eight hundred and eleven, and that the provisions of the act to which this is a supplement, be extended to persons the settlements under which they claim being made prior to the eighteenth June, one thousand seven hundred and forty-one, or between the eighteenth of June, one thousand seven hundred and forty one, and the eighteenth June, one thousand seven hundred and sixty-five, and also to persons through whose lands the line of the said Manor was run, or whose lines adjoin the same, although their names are not on the list of entries in the land-office upon the person or persons so applying, producing proof to the proper officer that they, or those under whom they claim, could not have perfected their titles within the period aforesaid.

CHAPTER XLVIII.

An ACT to alter the time of holding certain courts of quarter sessions and common pleas, in the county of Delaware.

SECT. I. *BE* it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That from and after the next April term, the April and July terms, of the courts of quarter sessions and common pleas, in the county of Delaware, shall commence and be holden on the second Monday in the month of April, and fourth Monday in the month of July, and that the continuance of the courts of common pleas aforesaid, be for one week only, any law or laws to the contrary notwithstanding.

Courts of quarter sessions and common pleas in Delaware county to be held, &c.
The common pleas to continue for one week.
