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CHAPTER LXI.

An ACT appropriating a sum of money for improving the road from Pittsburgh, through Canonsburgh, to the town of Washington, in the county of Washington.

SECT. I. *BE* it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same;

That the sum of fifteen hundred dollars be, and the same is hereby appropriated for the purpose of improving the road from the Monongahela river, opposite the town of Pittsburgh, by the way of the Coal-Hill in Allegheny county, through Canonsburgh to Washington, in Washington county.

SECT. II. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That at any time after the passage of this act, the state treasurer be, and he hereby is authorized and directed to pay the sum of seven hundred and fifty dollars to the commissioners of the county of Allegheny, which sum the said commissioners are required to expend on that part of said road, for the improvement thereof, which lies within the county of Allegheny.

SECT. III. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That at any time after the passage of this act, the state treasurer be, and he hereby is authorized and directed to pay the sum of seven hundred and fifty dollars to the commissioners of the county of Washington, which sum the commissioners are required to expend on that part of the road aforesaid, which lies between the town of Washington and the line which divides the counties of Washington and Allegheny.
