

CHAPTER CIX.

An Act Supplementary to an Act entitled "An Act for Regulating and Maintaining Fences."

SECTION I. *BE* it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That from and after the passing of this act, any three of the fence-viewers already appointed, or which may hereafter be appointed by the different courts of common pleas, in the several counties of this commonwealth, shall be a quorum for doing business; and any view or order which they may make in pursuance of or in discharge of the duties enjoined on them in the act to which this is a supplement shall be as firm and valid in law, as if the whole number appointed in any of the counties aforesaid, had viewed or adjudged the same according to the true intent and meaning of said act.

SECT. II. *And be* it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, That the fence-viewers aforesaid, or such of them as shall proceed to view, shall each of them receive a compensation for their services, of one dollar per day, for every day which they shall be engaged in any view under this act, which cost or expence shall be borne by both or either parties, as the said viewers shall direct, according to the provisions of the act to which this is a supplement.

One dollar per day allowed to. How paid.

 CHAPTER CX.

An Act to change the name of Charles Swift, junior, to Charles Riche.

WHEREAS it has been represented by Charles Swift junior, son of Charles Swift of the township of Bensalem in the county of Bucks, that at the request of a near relation, he has agreed to change his name from Charles Swift junior, to *Charles Riche*, and has prayed the legislature to sanction and confirm the said change of name. Therefore,

SECT. I. *BE* it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the said Charles Swift junior, shall hereafter be known

CHAPTER CXI.

An ACT authorizing the governor to incorporate a company for erecting a bridge over the Monongahela River, at or near where the road leading from Brownsville, to the town of Washington, crosses the same.

SECT. I. *BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,*

That Neal Gillespie junr. Parker Campbel and Thomas Acheson of the county of Washington, Jacob Bowman, Thomas Mason, Charles Shaffner, Samuel Jackson, David Ewing, and Michael Sowers of the county of Fayette be, and they are hereby appointed commissioners to do and perform the several duties hereafter mentioned, *that is to say:* They shall on or before the first day of October next, provide a book or books for the entering of subscriptions, and shall write therein as follows: We whose names are hereunto subscribed, do promise to pay to the president, managers and company, for erecting a bridge over the river Monongahela, at or near where the road leading from Brownsville to the town of Washington, crosses the same, the sum of twenty-five dollars for each and every share of stock in the said company, set opposite to our respective names in such manner and proportions, and at such times as shall be determined on by the president and managers, in pursuance of an act of the general assembly entitled: "An act authorising the governor to incorporate a company for erecting a bridge over the river Monongahela, at or near where the road leading from Brownsville to the town of Washington, crosses the same."
