CHAPTER LXI.

An ACT authorizing the sale of certain real estate late the property of James Stewart, of Luzerne county, deceased.

WHEREAS it satisfactorily appears to the legislature that it would be beneficial to the legatees of James Stewart, late of Luzerne county, deceased, to authorize the sale of part of said deceased's real estate; Therefore,

Orphan's court authorized to direet the sale of part, or the whole of the real estate of James Stewart, deceased, to pay debts, &c.

SECT. 1. Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the orphans' court of the county of Luzerne, be, and they are hereby empowered, upon the petition of the widow and executors, (or the survivor of them,) of the late James Stewart of the said county, deceased, to authorize the said executors or the survivor of them to sell, in such manner as the said court may deem best, the real estate of the said James Stewart, situate in the county aforesaid, for the payment of his debts and the maintenance and education of the minor children, or such part thereof as the said court may think the interest of the creditors, legatees, and devisees of the said James Stewart require, and to convey the same as fully and effectually to the purchaser, his heirs and assigns, as if they had been authorized so to do, by the will of the said James Stewart: Provided, That before they make any such order the said court shall take from the said executors a bond with sufficient security conditioned for the faithful performance of the trust reposed in them, and for the application

of the monies arising from such sales, to the purposes directed by the said court.

CHAPTER LXIL

An ACT supplementary to an act entitled, " An act to authorize the governor to incorporate a company for execting a bridge over the river Susquehanna at the borough of Wilkesbarre, in the county of Luzerne.

SECT. I. BE it enucted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met. and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That John H. Two commis-Brinton of the city of Philadelphia, and Henry Buckingham of sioners appointed to supply va-the county of Luzerne, be, and they are hereby appointed commissioners in the place and stead of Thomas Allibone of the city of Philadelphia, and Lawrence Myers of the county of Luzerne, deceased; who, with the commissioners in the act to which this is a supplement named, or a majority of them, shall commissioners. have power to do and perform the several duties, and shall be under the same restrictions, as are mentioned in the act to which this is supplementary; *Provided always*, that if the said proviso, company shall not within five years after the date of this act time for comproceed in the erection of said bridge, agreeably to the true in-mening and completing the tent and meaning of the act to which this is a supplement, and work. shall not within ten years from the passing of this act complete the same, it shall and may be lawful for the legislature of this commonwealth to resume all and singular the rights, liberties and privileges, granted to the said company.
