CHAPTER LXXXVII.

An ACT supplementary to an act entitled, “ An act establishing the seat of government of the commonwealth of Pennsylvania, at Harrisburgh, in the county of Dauphin.”

SECT. I. BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the sum of thirty thousand dollars be, and the same is hereby appropriated for the completion of the fire-proof offices, the building of which was authorized by the sixth section of the act to which this is supplementary,

30 000 dollars appropriated to complete the fire-proof offices at Harrisburgh.

SECT. II. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, That the money hereby appropriated or so much thereof, as shall be necessary, shall be paid by the treasurer of the commonwealth on the order of any two of the commissioners appointed under the act aforesaid, who are hereby enjoined and required to keep regular and true accounts of all the monies they expend in completing the offices aforesaid, and to transmit said accounts with the necessary vouchers to the auditor-general once in every three months, who shall examine the same and make report to the legislature on or before the first Monday of January next.

To be paid on the order of any two of the commissioners who are to exhibit their accounts, quarterly to the auditor-general.

Auditor-general to make report to the legislature.
