CHAPTER XLIV.

*An ACT granting an annuity to Henry Pensinger, an old soldier, who lost a leg in the revolutionary war.*

Grant to Henry Pensinger.

SECT. I. *BE it enacted by the senate and house of representatives of the commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in general assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the state treasurer be, and he is hereby directed to pay to Henry Pensinger, or his lawful attorney, the sum of forty dollars immediately, and the further sum of sixty dollars annually during life, in half-yearly payments, out of any money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated, to commence on the first day of January, one thousand eight hundred and twelve.
