CHAPTER LI.

An ACT for altering the state road in Bedford county.

SECT. 1. *BE it enacted by the senate and house of representatives of the commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in general assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That so much of the state road in the county of Bedford, as follows, *viz.* beginning at the run near the house of William Todd, then westwardly by the house now occupied by John Ewalt, one hundred and fifty-seven perches or thereabouts, be and the same is hereby established on, and along the ground, where the same has been hitherto travelled, so as to branch off from the Glade road, at the said house of John Ewalt ; and the part of the road, laid out along the distance aforesaid, north of the tract hitherto travelled, as aforesaid, be and the same is hereby vacated.
