

said Margaret Delaney, evicted from sixty acres and ninety-six and an half perches of the premises aforesaid; and whereas, it is just and reasonable that the said John Wilson, and the said David Hess, should be indemnified for the loss they have sustained in consequence of said eviction from their property: Therefore,

SECT. I. *Be it enacted by the senate and house of representatives of the commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in general assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the state-treasurer is hereby authorized and required to pay to John Wilson, his heirs or assigns, the sum of one hundred and twenty-six dollars and thirteen cents, in full compensation for principal, interest, all costs and damages he has paid, by being evicted by due course of law, from fifty-two acres and twenty perches of land, in Allen township, Northampton county, under a title derived from this commonwealth.

SECT. II. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That the state-treasurer is hereby authorized and required, to pay to David Hess, his heirs or assigns, the sum of one hundred and forty-eight dollars and seven cents, in full compensation for principal, interest, all costs and damages he has paid, by being evicted by due course of law from sixty acres ninety-six and an half perches of land, in Allen township, Northampton county, under a title derived from this commonwealth.

CHAPTER LXIII.

*An ACT granting a tract of donation land to Jacob Speider, an old soldier.*

SECT. I. *BE it enacted by the senate and house of representatives of the commonwealth of Pennsylvania in general assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same* That the land officers be, and they are hereby directed to draw and patent to Jacob Speider and his heirs, two hundred acres of donation land
