CHAPTER LXVI.

An ACT authorizing the governor to centract with John Binns. for printing a certain number of copies of such parts of the English statute law, as is reported by the judges of the supreme court to be in force within this commonwealth, and to provide for the distribution thereof.

SECT. 1. BE it enacted by the senate and house of representatives of the commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in general assembly The governor met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the governor be, and he hereby is authorized and required to receive proposals, and contract with John Binns, for seven hundred and fifty copies of his proposed edition of all the copies of the English statutes, which are in force in Pennsylvania as reported by the judges of the supreme court, together with their report on that subject, to be printed correctly on good paper, with small pica type, in one volume royal octavo, and to be well bound and lettered, Provided, the same shall not exceed two dollars per copy; And provided, that no money shall be paid on said contract until the work is completed, examined and approved by the attorney-general, and the secretary of the commonwealth, and deposited in his office.

And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, That the said work shall be distributed by the secretary of the commonwealth to the same officers for the time being, and for the same uses, and under the same conditions as the last edition of the laws of Pennsylvania, published by John Bioren, have been distributed, as soon as convenient after they

have been received and approved as aforesaid.
