CHAPTER LXXIX.

An ACT for the relief of David Davidson, an old soldier.

SECT. 1. *BE it enacted by the senate and house of representatives of the commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in general assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the state-treasurer, be and he is hereby directed to pay unto David Davidson, or order, the sum of forty dollars immediately and an annuity of forty dollars during his life, payable half yearly, to commence from the first day of January, one thousand eight hundred and twelve. CHAPTER LXXX.

An ACT to cede to the United States, the jurisdiction over a piece of land at Presque' Isle, for a light house.

WHEREAS, the congress of the United States, by an act passed the first day of May, in the year of our Lord, one thousand eight hundred and ten, authorized the erection of a light house at or near Presque' Isle, and appropriated a sum of money to defray the expense of erecting the same :

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the senate and house of representatives of the commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in general assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That for the purpose of erecting a light-house, jurisdiction is hereby ceded to the United States, in and over the following tract or piece A piece of ground ceded to the U.
