### CHAPTER CL.

An ACT for the relief of Alexander Brown, Samuel Watt, and Patrick Martin, old soldiers.

SECT. I. BE it enacted by the senate and house of representatives of the commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in general assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the state treasurer be, and he is hereby directed to pay unto Alexander Brown, of Bedford county, or order, the sum of forty dollars, immediately after the passing of this act, and an annuity of forty dollars, payable half yearly, during his life, to commence from the first day of January last.

SECT. II. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, That the state treasurer be, and he is hereby directed to pay unto Samuel Watt, the sum of forty dollars, immediately after the passing of this act.

SECT. III. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, That the state treasurer be, and he is hereby directed to pay unto Patrick Martin, the sum of forty dollars, immediately after the passing of this act.

### CHAPTER CLI.
