SECT. I. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That it shall be the duty of the court of general quarter sessions of the peace, of Bedford county, on application to them made, to order and direct a survey and draught of the road hereby laid out and established, to be made at the expense of said county, the draft whereof shall be deposited, and remain a record in the office of the clerk of the court of general quarter sessions of the peace aforesaid; and the supervisors of the township or townships, through which the said road shall or may pass, are hereby directed and enjoined to open and keep it in repair, under the same penalties, rules, restrictions and remedies provided for opening and keeping in repair roads laid out under the authority of the courts of general quarter sessions of the peace, in this commonwealth.

CHAPTER III.

*A SUPPLEMENT to the act, entitled, "An act to incorporate Loller academy, in the village of Hatborough, in the county of Montgomery."*

SECT. I. *BE it enacted by the senate and house of representatives of the commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in general assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That from and after the passing of this act, the annual election for trustees of Loller academy, shall be held under the same rules, regulations and restrictions, as are mentioned in the act to which this is a supplement, on the first Monday in December; and that the period for which the present trustees are elected, shall expire on the last Saturday in December, one thousand eight hundred and twelve; and an election shall be held on that day for trustees, to continue in office until the first Monday in December thereafter.

The time for electing trustees.

SECT. II. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That so much of the act to which this is a supplement, as is hereby altered and supplied, be and the same is hereby repealed.
