net, and it is bereby enacted by the authority of the same, That Sheriff of Schuyl it shall and may be lawful for the sheriff of Schuylkill county thorized to receive all and every person who may now be confined in the jail of Berks county, in consequence of any legal process Barks county. issued by proper authority from Schuylkill county, and convey him, her or them, to the jail of Schuylkill county, and to keep him, her or them in close custody, until they or either of them, shall be discharged by due course of law, as well as all other persons who may be in his custody by virtue of legal process issued by proper authority, in the county of Schuylkill.

SECT, II. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, That the second, third and fourth sections of the act, Part of a former entitled, "A further supplement to the act, entitled, "An act repealed. act for erecting part of Berks and Northampton counties into a separate county," be, and the same are hereby repealed.
