An ACT granting certain privileges to the mayor, aldermen, and citizens of Philadelphia, in relation to the highways, streets, and roads of Penn township, in the county of Philadelphia.

Sect. 1. BE it enacted by the senate and house of representatives of the commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in general assembly met, and it is bereby enacted by the authority of the same, That Mayer and at-from and after the passing of this act, it shall and may be law-rized to use cerful for the mayor, aldermen and citizens of Philadelphia, to tain streets for make use of any of the public highways, streets and roads of and repairing conduit tipes, Penn township, in the county of Philadelphia, for the purpose &c. of laying down (re-laying) and repairing of conduit pipes, and the usual and necessary devices connected with the same, for supplying the city of Philadelphia, and the adjoining districts with water: provided always, that the laying, re-laying and provise that the public streets, repairing of the said conduit pipes, and the usual and necessa- &c. be not obstructed. ry devices connected therewith, shall be done in such manner as not to obstruct the passage of the said highways, streets or roads, and that all damage or injury which may ensue to and repair damages. the said highways, streets or roads, from the exercise of the privilege hereby granted, shall be repaired by the said corporation at its own proper costs.

CHAPTER LVII.

An ACT authorizing Andrew Bozorth, and doctor Phineas fenks, executors of the last will and testament of Hannah Dyer, deceased, to sell and convey a certain tract of land therein mentioned.

WHEREAS it appears that Hannah Dyer, late of the township of Northampton, in the county of Bucks, deceased, was seized in her life-time of a certain tract or parcel of land, situate in the county and township aforesaid, which she by her last will and testament did bequeath and devise, to Andrew Bozorth, Sarah Dyer Bozorth, and doctor Phineas Jenks, to hold to them, and their heirs and assigns, (as more fully appears in the said will;) and whereas, the said Andrew Bozorth, and doctor Phineas Jenks, executors named in the will

aforesaid, and to whom letters testamentary were regularly granted, have by petition prayed that a law may be passed authorizing them to sell and convey the share or interest which the said Sarah Dyer Bozorth hath in the said land, and to apply the proceeds thereof to her use: Therefore,

SECT. 1. Be it enacted by the senate and house of representatives of the commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in general assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That Andrew Bozorth, and doctor Phineas Jenks, executors of the right of the said deceased, in and empowered by public sale, to sell all the right, title and a certain estate. to her by Hannah Dyer, deceased, for the best possible price that can be procured for the same, andlby a sufficient deed convey to the purchaser or purchasers in fee simple all the estate aforesaid; provided, that the said Andrew Bozorth, before the aforesaid executors enter upon the duties directed to be performed by this act, shall enter into a recognizance in the orphans' court of the county of Bucks, with one or more sureties, to the satisfaction of the said court, conditioned that the duties in this act mentioned shall be faithfully performed, and the proceeds of the sale hereby authorized, shall be vested in more productive real estate, unincumbered by ground rent, or otherwise, in trust for the use of the said Sarah Dyer Bozorth, her heirs and assigns.

An ACT to authorize the governor to appoint commissioners to lay out certain roads, therein mentioned, and for other purposes.

SECT. 1. BE it enacted by the senate and house of representailves of the commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in general assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That missioners to lay the governor be, and he is hereby authorized to appoint three commissioners, one of whom shall be a practical surveyor, to lay out and mark a road, beginning at the town of Indiana, in Indiana county, and from thence by the nearest and best route to Pittsburg, in the county of Allegheny; and the said commissioners shall proceed to perform the said service at such road to be depo-time as the governor shall direct, and they shall deposit a co-sited in the office py of a draught of the said road in the office of the clerk of the
