CHAPTER LXIV.

An ACT for the relief of Joshua Williams, late a captain in the fourth Pennsylvania regiment.

WHEREAS Joshua Williams, late a captain in the fourth Pennsylvania regiment, entered the service of his country, early in the year one thousand seven hundred and seventy-six, in the flying camp, and in one thousand seven hundred and seventyeight, and one thousand seven hundred and seventy-nine, rendered essential service to general Wayne, for which service he never received any compensation: and whereas, the said Joshua Williams is now old and infirm, and in indigent circumstances: Therefore,

SECT 1. Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in general assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That 100 dollars grant-the state treasurer be, and he is hereby directed to pay unto liams.
