And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, Time of holding That as soon as the said county shall become attached to and form part of the said district or circuit, in pursuance of this act, the several courts shall commence on the last Mondays of December, March, July, and October, and be holden for the same time and in the same manner, as is prescribed by the laws of this commonwealth.

SECT. XI. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, That so much of the act to which this is a supplement, as is hereby altered or supplied, be and the same is hereby repealed.
