CHAPTER CXXXI.

An ACT to amend and continue an act, entitled, "An act to incorporate the Delaware Insurance Company of Philadelphia."

SECT 1. BE it enacted by the senate and house of representatives of the commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in general assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That The limitation of the act entitled, "An act to incorporate the Delaware Insurance extended." Company of Philadelphia," passed the twelfth day of March, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and four, and every part thereof, (except as hereinafter excepted, and except the limitation therein,) be and the same hereby is continued in full force and virtue, for the term of twenty years from the first day of January, in the year of our Lord, one thousand eight hundred and fifteen.

SECT. 11. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, That from and after the passing of this act the capital stock of Conital stock of the said "Delaware Insurance Company of Philadelphia," shall 200,000 dollars, be deemed and taken to be the sum of two hundred thousand contains. be deemed and taken to be the sum of two hundred thousand dollars, divided into five thousand shares of forty dollars each, and no more, any thing in the said recited act to the contrary notwithstanding; provided, that nothing in this act contained Provises shall be taken or construed to affect or lessen the security of any debt or contract whatsoever, which may have been entered into with said company before the passing of this act.

SECT. III. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, That so much of the said recited act, and no more, as is hereby Repealing clauses supplied or altered, be and the same is hereby repealed; provided, Proviso that if it shall at any time appear that the privileges hereby renewed and granted, are injurious to the interests of this commonwealth, the legislature shall be at liberty to annul them.
