work; one fourth when half of the superstructure of said bridge shall have been raised; and the remaining fourth part when the said bridge shall have been completed: and on the Certificates of payment of each fourth part, the president and treasurer of the said company shall deliver to the state treasurer, for the use of the commonwealth, a certificate for eleven hundred and twentyfive shares of stock in the said company, and no other certificates shall be required on the part of the state, for the shares held by the state, in the stock of said company.
