CHAPTER XXXVIII.

An ACT for the relief of the militia of this state when called into the service of the United States.

Sect. 1. BE it enacted by the senate and house of representatives of the commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in general assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the non commissioned officers and privates of the militia and volun-in advance to the teers or any part thereof, that are now called or may hereafter militia in service &c. be called into the service of the United States, shall be paid in advance the sum of six dollars, which sum shall be considered as a part of the additional payallowed by the sixth section of the act of the twenty-ninth of March, one thousand eight hundred and thirteen, which sums shall be paid out of the treasury of this state by the governor, on warrants drawn by him in favour of a Governor to paymaster or paymasters, by him to be appointed from time to by warrants and appoint a time, as he may deem necessary, which paymaster shall be sub-paymaster. ject to the same conditions and restrictions and receive the same compensation as is provided by the seventh, eighth and ninth sections of the act aforesaid.
