CHAPTER CXXIX.

An ACT regulating the mode of charging interest on land in certain cases, and for other purposes.

Sect. I. BE it enacted by the senate and house of representatives of the commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in general assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That from and after the passing of this act, it shall be lawful for the secretary of the land office to issue warrants to any person entitled thereto, within the purchase of one thousand seven hundred and sixty-eight or the previous purchases at the rate of ten mode of charge chase of one thousand seven hundred and sixty-eight from the unian in certain case of one thousand seven hundred and sixty-eight from the tain cases first day of March, one thousand seven hundred and seventy and within the previous purchases from the first day of March, one thousand seven hundred and fifty five, in cases where the applicant cannot obtain proof of the time the said land was first improved as required by the existing laws.

Sect. 11. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,
That from and after the first day of June next, so much of the certain acts act of the twenty-second of September, one thousand seven hundred and ninety-four as requires a settlement, residence and raising of grain, as also so much of the act of the third of April, one thousand seven hundred and ninety two, as reduces the price of lands to fifty shillings per hundred acres, be and the

same are hereby repealed, so far as respects lands within the purchase of one thousand seven hundred and sixty eight and the previous purchases: provided, that nothing herein contained Proviso. shall impair or affect the right of any person who may have actually settled on vacant land before the passing of this act.
