## CHAPTER CLX.

An ACT to authorize the holding of adjourned courts of quarter sessions, in Allegheny county.

SECT. I. BE it enacted by the senate and bouse of representatives of the commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in general assembly met, and it is bereby enacted by the authority of the same. That from and after the passage of this act the court of quarter sessions of Allegheny county, if the business of the court shall require it, may be continued and held during the whole week of each and every term; and the judges of the same court are hereby authorized to hold adjourned courts of quarter sessions for two weeks in each year, if the increase of business, or the unfinished business in the sessions require it, under the same rules and regulations in all respects as the regular and stated sessions are now held, except that no grand juries shall be summoned to said adjourned courts.

The judges of Allegheny county may hold adjourned courts.

## CHAPTER CLXI.

An ACT enabling the governor to incorporate a company for making an artificial road from Pawling's ford bridge, on the river Schuylkill, to intersect the Little Conestogoe tarnpike road at or near the western line of Herman Pennepacker's land in the county of Chester.

Sect. 1. BE it enacted by the senate and house of representa-

tives of the commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in general assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That Elijah Funk, Lewis Morgan, Doctor Samuel Nixon, John Emery, Matthias Pennypacker, Lawrence Hipple and Robert Ralston of the county of Chester, John Markley, Lewis Shrack and George Hawke, of the county of Montgomery, be and they are hereby appointed commissioners to do and perform the several duties hereinafter mentioned: that is to say, they shall on or before the last Monday in May next procure one or more books, and in each of them enter as follows: "We whose names are hereunto subscribed, do promise to pay to the president and managers of the Pickering creek turnpike road company, the sum of fifty dollars, for every share of stock in said company, set opposite our respective names, in such manner and proportions, and at such times, as shall be determined by the president and managers of the said company, in pursuance of an act of the general assembly of this commonwealth, entitled "An act enabling the gover-
