CHAPTER CLXII.

An ACT to repeal part of an act entitled "An Act establishing an Academy in the town of Franklin in Venango county and granting a sum of money thereto."

SECT. I. BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That so much of an act, entitled "An act establishing an academy in the town of Franklin in Venango county, and granting a sum of money thereto," passed the twenty-eighth of January, eighteen hundred and thirteen, as requires the trustees of said academy to certify that subscriptions to the amount of five hundred dollars, have been obtained and secured to be paid for the use of said academy, and that the said trustees have proceeded to erect the buildings, be and the same is hereby repealed.

CHAPTER CLXIII.

An ACT for the further establishment and regulation of election districts.

SECT. I. BE it enacted by the senate and house of representatives of the commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in general assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the electors within the district composed of the townships of Kingsessing and Blockley, in Philadelphia county, shall hold their general elections at the house now occupied by George C. Lintner, on the West Chester road in said district.
