CHAPTER VIII.

RESOLVED, *by the Senate and House of Representatives of the commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met*, That the secretary of the commonwealth be and he is hereby authorized and required to distribute to the prothonotaries of the city of Philadelphia and different counties of said commonwealth, ~~as many copies of Smith's edition of the Laws of Pennsylvania as may be sufficient to supply with one set~~, each associate judge and justice of the peace, who may have been commissioned since the year one thousand eight hundred and eight, and who were not entitled to the same by virtue of a resolution, passed on the twenty ninth day of March, one thousand eight hundred and thirteen, accompanied by a schedule or list of appointments embraced by this resolution:—And the prothonotaries on the receipt thereof, shall deliver to the justices of the peace and judges aforesaid each one copy, taking a receipt for the same, in which a clause shall be inserted obliging them respectively to deliver over the said copies to their successors in office: *provided*, that no justice of the peace who may have been commissioned since the period first above mentioned, and shall have come into office as the successor of any justice of the peace who has already received said copy by virtue of the resolution aforesaid, shall be entitled to the same.
