CHAPTER I.

An ACT, granting further time for completing the Susquehanna and Tioga turnpike road.

Sect. 1. BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the limitation contained in the third section of the act, entitled "An act to enable the governor of this commonwealth to incorporate a company for making an artificial road by the best and nearest route from Berwick, on the north east branch of the Susquehanna, or from Further time from Berwick, on the north east branch of the Susquehanna, or from allowed for the mouth of the Lower Whopehawley, to that point on the north completing line of the state which is nearest to Newtown, on the river Tioga, the Susquein the state of New York," passed on the twenty-eighth day of hama & Tio-March, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ga turnpike six be, and the same is hereby repealed, so far as respects the time road. within which it, or the act referred to by it, would otherwise require the said road to be finished; and, that a further period of ten years from and after the passing of this act be, and the same hereby is allowed and granted to the president, managers and company of the Susquehanna and Tioga turnpike road, for carrying on and completing the same, and they and their successors shall henceforth and until the end of the said period have, exercise and enjoy all the

rights, powers, privileges and franchises to which, by the said recited act, and the supplement thereto, they are now entitled.
