settle his accounts with the accountant officers, in the manner prescribed by law for similar accounts.

Sect. III. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, so Governor to That the governor be, and he is hereby authorized to draw his wardraw warrant rant on the state treasurer, in favor of such paymaster, for the sums payable by virtue of this act, which shall be paid out of any monies in the treasury not otherwise appropriated.

## CHAPTER XXX.

An ACF to extend the boundaries of Northumberland county.

Sect. 1. BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly Townships of met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That Turbit and from and after the first day of May next, the townships of Turbit Chillisquaque annexed and Chillisquaque, in the county of Columbia, be, and the same are to Northum. hereby annexed to and made part of Northumberland county: Provided, That all taxes or arrears of taxes laid, or which have become berland due within the townships aforesaid, before the passing of this act, and county. Proviso as to all sums of money due to this commonwealth for militia fines within taxes, militia said townships, shall be collected and received as if this act had not been passed: And provided also, That the sheriff, coroner and other Sheriffs, coofficers of the county of Columbia, other than the justices of the roners, justi-peace, shall continue to exercise the duties of their respective offices ces of the within said townships, until the business appertaining to the duties peace, &c. of their offices respectively, and which shall have been commenced therein previous to the passing of this act, shall have been finally settled.

Part of the electors of Turbit to elect at Milton: SECT. II. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, That that part of the township of Turbit, whose inhabitants now elect at Washington, shall hereafter elect at Milton, and be attached to the eighth election district.
