CHAPTER XII.

RESOLVED, by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, That the secretary of the commonwealth be, and he hereby is authorized and required to procure for the use of the legislature, if the same can conveniently be had, two copies of such parts of the Journals of the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States, from the commencement of the present constitution, as are not in possession of this legislature, so that each house may have one complete and entire copy thereof.

RESOLVED, That the secretary of this commonwealth be, and he hereby is required to transmit to each of the members of the present legislature, a copy of the pamphlet edition of the laws of the

present session.
