

CHAPTER III.

A further SUPPLEMENT to an act, entitled "An act to enable the Governor of this Commonwealth to incorporate a company for making an artificial road from the intersection of Front street and the Germantown road in the Northern Liberties of the city of Philadelphia, through Frankford and Bristol, to the ferry at Morrisville on the river Delaware."

SECT. I. *BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the president, managers and company of the Frankford and Bristol turnpike road, be, and they hereby are authorised, whenever it shall appear by the abstract of the accounts of the said road and of the permanent bridge where the same crosses the Neshaminy creek, that the clear annual income of both will not bear a dividend of six per centum per annum on the whole capital stock expended on it, to increase the tolls on the whole or on said bridge, so much upon every allowance thereof as will raise the dividend up to six per centum per annum on the whole or on the capital stock of the said bridge. Tolls authorised to be raised in certain cases.

CHAPTER IV.

A SUPPLEMENT to an act, entitled "An act to erect the town of Hanover in the county of York, into a borough."

SECT. I. *BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That any person who may hereafter be elected as Burgess, or a member of the town council, or constable of the borough of Hanover, in the county of York, agreeably to an act of Assembly passed the fourth day of March, one thousand eight hundred and fifteen, shall not be liable to serve contrary to his own inclination, more than one year in the term of five years, any thing contained in the act to which this is a supplement to the contrary in any wise notwithstanding. Borough officers not compelled to serve more than one year out of five.
