CHAPTER XXXVII.

An ACT to regulate the payment of costs in certain cases of trespass therein mentioned.

SECT. I. *BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same*, That in ail actions for the recovery of damages for any trespass, wrong or injury done or committed against real or personal estate, brought before any justice of the peace or alderman of this commonwealth, and referred agreeably to law, the referees are hereby empowered, in addition to their report of the dama- ^{Referees to} ^{decide who} ges, if any sustained by the plaintiff, to decide and report also ^{decide who} whether the plaintiff or defendant shall pay the costs of such shall pay ^{costs.} action, or in what proportion they shall be paid by the plaintiff costs.

er defendant respectively, on which report judgment shall be entered, as well for the costs as the damages, and execution shall issue as in other cases: any thing in the second section of the act entitled, "An act regulating the proceedings of justices of the peace and aldermen, in cases of trespass, trover and rent," passed the twenty-second day of March, one thousand eight hundred and fourteen, or in any other act to the contrary notwithstanding.

CHAPTER XXXVIII.

An ACT enabling the governor to incorporate a company for making an artificial road from the state line near the town of Emmetsburg, in the state of Maryland, to intersect the Chambersburg and Bedford turnpike road at or near Loudontown, in Franklin county.

SECT. I. *BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That* William Miller, William Bools, Emanuel Stover, John M'Lain, Lazarus Brown, Benjamin Kyser, Alexander M'Coy, Jeremiah Hamilton, James M'Dowell and Thomas Scott, be, and they are hereby appointed commissioners to do and perform the several duties hereinafter mentioned, that is to say, They shall, on or before the first Monday in June next, procure one or more books and in each of them enter as follows: "We whose names are hereunto subscribed, do promise to pay to the president and managers of the Loudontown turnpike road company, the sum of one hundred dollars for every share of stock in said company set opposite our respective names, in such manner and proportions, and at such times as shall be determined by the president and managers of the said company, in pursuance of an act of the general assembly of this commonwealth, entitled "An act enabling the governor to incorporate a company for making an artificial road from the state line near the town of Emmetsburg, in the state of Maryland, to intersect the Chambersburg and Bedford turnpike road at or near Loudontown, in Franklin county;" and shall thereupon give notice in all of the public papers printed in the borough of Chambersburg, and one published in the borough of Gettysburg, respectively, for one calendar month at least, of the times and places when and where the said books shall be kept open to receive subscriptions for the stock of the said company, at which respective times and places some one or
