*met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the governor be, and he is hereby authorised and required to subscribe, on behalf of the commonwealth, for two hundred shares of stock of the company for making a turnpike road from Middletown to Harrisburg, and as soon as any section of the said road (not less than three miles) shall be completed and approved of, as is directed by the act to which this is a supplement, the governor is further authorised and required to draw his warrant on the state treasurer, in favor of the said company, for such part of the amount of stock to be paid by the commonwealth, as shall be in proportion to the whole distance of the said turnpike road, and so from time to time until the whole of the road shall be completed.*

*SECT. II. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, That the subscriptions and payments authorised to be made by this act, shall, for every share subscribed and paid, vest in this commonwealth all the rights, estates and emoluments appertaining to a share or shares held by individual stockholders.*

### CHAPTER LIII.

A SUPPLEMENT to an act, entitled “An act for the erection of a poor-house for the better relief and employment of the poor in the townships of Oxford and Lower Dublin, in the county of Philadelphia.”

*SECT. I. BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That so much of the twenty-first section of “An act for the consolidation and amendment of the laws, as far as they respect the poor of the city of Philadelphia, the district of Southwark, and the township of the Northern Liberties,” passed the twenty-ninth of March, one thousand eight hundred and three, as relates to the aldermen and justices of the peace granting orders for the removal of paupers, be, and the same is hereby extended to the townships of Oxford and Lower Dublin, in the county of Philadelphia.*
