## CHAPTER I.

### AN ACT

To authorise the Trustees of the German religious society of Roman Catholics of the Holy Trinity Church in the city of Philadelphia, to sell and convey a lot of ground with the building thereon in the city of Philadelphia.

Sect. 1. BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the Trustees of same, That it shall and may be lawful for the trustees of the Holy Trinity German Religious Society of Roman Catholics, of the Holy thorized to Trinity Church in the city of Philadelphia, after public nosell real tice previously given, in at least two news papers printed in estate the said city, to sell for the highest price that can be obtained, a frame tenement and lot of ground, situate on Sassafras Alley in the said city, containing in breadth on the said alley, about fifteen feet and a half, and in depth, forty feet, devis-

ed in the will of John Conrad, late of the city of Philadelphia, deceased, to the said corporation, by the name of the German Roman Catholic Church, called the Holy Trinity Church in the city of Philadelphia, and to execute, seal, and deliver, and in due form of law, acknowledge such conveyances and assurances of the said estate, unto the purchaser or purchasers thereof, their heirs and assigns for ever, as shall be requisite. Provided, That the said trustees and their successors, shall place out on mortgage on good real estate, the purchase money received by them for the said lot of ground and Directing the buildings, and apply the interest of the said mortgage as a appropriati- fund for schooling of poor children belonging to the said conon of the proceeds of the gregation, gratis, agreeably to the true intent and meaning of the last will and testament of the said John Conrad.

### CHAPTER II.

#### AN ACT

To vest in the trustees of the German religious society of Roman Catholics of the Holy Trinity Church, in the city of Philadelphia, the right of this Commonwealth, to the estate of Francis Doering, late of the city of Philadelphia, deceased.

Escheafed estate vested in certain trustees.

SECT 1. BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That all the right, title and interest which this commonwealth may have acquired by reason of any escheat or supposed escheat, from the want of heirs or any known kindred of Francis Doering, formerly of the city of Philadelphia, deceased, in and to the estate, real and personal, whereof he died seized or possessed, shall be and the same is hereby vested in the trustees of the German religious so-
