

CHAPTER XXV.

AN ACT

For the relief of Joseph Johnston, of Beaver county.

SECT. 1. *BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the state treasurer is hereby authorised and directed to pay to Joseph Johnston, of Beaver county, or his order, the sum of three hundred and seventy-five dollars, in full of his claim for a tract of donation land in the second district Mercer county, containing two hundred acres, number one thousand eight hundred and eighty-one, which was granted to the said Joseph Johnston, but upon examination was found to have been previously granted to another.*

CHAPTER XXVI.

AN ACT

To enable the Governor to incorporate a company for making an artificial road from Danville, in the county of Columbia, by the best and nearest route to Pennsborough, in the county of Lycoming.

SECT. 1. *BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That Daniel Montgomery, Mathew S. Colvin, Nathaniel Spence, Thomas Moorhead and Philip Goodman, of the county of Columbia, and John M. Means, Joseph Wood, George Webb, John Becher, John Brindle and Jacob Shoemaker, of the county of Lycoming, be, and they are hereby appointed commissioners to do and perform the several things hereinafter mentioned, that is to say, They shall on or before the first Monday of November next, procure two or more books and enter*
