CHAPTER LXXV.

A FURTHER SUPPLEMENT

To the act entitled "An act for the appointment and regulation of constables in the township of the Northern Liberties, in the county of Philadelphia."

Time of
electing con-
stables alter-

SECT. 1. *BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the additional constables to be elected in the township of the Northern Liberties, in the county of Philadelphia, by the supplement to the act to which this is a further supplement, shall hereafter be elected on the Friday immediately preceding the third Saturday in the month of March in each and every year: and so much of the said supplement, passed on the fifth day of March, eighteen hundred and sixteen, as is hereby altered or supplied, be, and the same is hereby repealed.
