sum of two hundred dollars immediately after the passing of this act, and an additional annuity of three hundred and fifty dollars during life, to be paid half yearly, to commence on the first day of January, one thousand eight hundred and seventeen.

CHAPTER LXXIX.

AN ACT

To increase the number of constables in the borough of Harrisburg.

SECT. 1. BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That from and after the passing of this act, the electors qualified to vote for members of the General Assembly, residing within the borough of Harrisburg, shall hereafter, annually, on the third Friday in March, elect six suitable persons for the office of constable, and make a regular return of such election to the court of quarter sessions of Dauphin county, and the said court shall appoint three of the persons so elected, to serve as constables for said borough, conformably to law.
