

CHAPTER LXXX.

AN ACT

To authorise the Governor to employ counsel in certain actions of ejectments instituted by the representatives of George Croghan, deceased, in the Circuit Court of the United States for the district of Pennsylvania.

SECT. 1. *BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the Governor be, and he is hereby authorised to employ counsel to appear for the defendants in all suits pending in the Circuit Court of the United States, held in the city of Philadelphia for the district of Pennsylvania, which may have been instituted by the representatives of George Croghan, deceased, against persons holding lands by virtue of titles derived from the Commonwealth, in the county of Beaver.

SECT. 2. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That the Governor be, and he is hereby authorised and required to draw a warrant or warrants on the state treasurer, in favor of said counsel, for a sum not exceeding one thousand dollars, for their services in attending to and defending the aforesaid suits.

CHAPTER LXXXI.

AN ACT

For the relief of Ruth Hatrick and Ann Dorothy Gettig.

SECT. 1. *BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the state treasurer be, and he is hereby required to pay to Ruth Hatrick, or her order, widow of William Hatrick, late of Berks county, a soldier in the late war, fifty dollars immediately after the passing of this act.
