And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, That the Governor be, and he is hereby authorised and required to draw a warrant or warrants on the state treasurer, in favor of said counsel, for a sum not exceeding one thousand dollars, for their services in attending to and defending the aforesaid suits.

CHAPTER LXXXI.

For the relief of Ruth Hatrick and Ann Dorothy Gettig.

Sect. 1. BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the state treasurer be, and he is hereby required Gratuity of \$50 to theto pay to Ruth Hatrick, or her order, widow of William Hatwidow of Wm. Hatrick rick, late of Berks county, a soldier in the late war, fifty dollars immediately after the passing of this act.

And be it further enacted by the authority afore-said, That the state treasurer be, and he is hereby required Gratuity and to pay to Ann Dorothy Gettig, of Northumberland county, or annuity of her order, widow of the late lieutenant Gettig, an officer in \$40 to the the revolutionary army, forty dollars immediately, and forty widow of dollars annually, to be paid half yearly during life, to commence the first day of January, eighteen hundred and seventeen.

CHAPTER LXXXII.

A SUPPLEMENT

'To the act entitled "An act to authorise the purchase and distribution of certain copies of the new edition of the laws of the United States."

SECT. 1.
