#### AN ACT

To improve the navigation of the river Delaware.

Sect. 1. BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That Jacob Mixsell, of the borough of Easton, and Lewis S.
