CHAPTER CLXIII.

AN ACT

To extend the powers of the Gettysburg and Black's tavern turnpike company.

SECT. 1. BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That "the Gettysburg and Black's tavern turnpike company" be, and they are hereby authorised to extend an artificial road from Black's tavern, to intersect the Harrisburg and Chambersburg turnpike road at or near the west end of the town of Shippensburg, in Cumberland county, by the nearest and best route, and shall have power to enlarge their stock for that purpose, and generally shall have the like power and authority for laying out, carrying on and completing the extension as aforesaid of the said road, and be subject to all the duties, qualifications, restrictions, penalties, fines and forfeitures, and be entitled to like tolls and profits in proportion to the distance, as are given to them by the act under which they are incorporated.
