CHAPTER XV.

AN ACT

To increase the number of constables in the township of Germantown, in the county of Philadelphia.

SECT. 1. *BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the electors of the township of Germantown, in the county of Philadelphia, shall annually, on the day appointed for the election of constables in the different townships in this commonwealth, hereafter elect four suitable persons, inhabitants of said township, and return the names of the persons so elected to the next general court of quarter sessions to be held for the county of Philadelphia, two of whom shall be appointed constables for the said township, in the same manner, with like powers and authority, and subject to the same regulations and penalties, as are provided and contained in the several laws of this commonwealth relating to constables.
