right or rights of any individual or individuals which shall remain as fully as if this act had not been passed.

CHAPTER XV.

AN ACT

To increase the number of constables in the township of Germantown, in the county of Philadelphia.

Sect. 1. BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the electors of the township of Germantown, in Township of the county of Philadelphia, shall annually, on the day aptoclet four pointed for the election of constables in the different town-persons as ships in this commonwealth, hereafter elect four suitable perconstables. sons, inhabitants of said township, and return the names of the persons so elected to the next general court of quarter Court of sessions to be held for the county of Philadelphia, two of quarter seswhom shall be appointed constables for the said township, in sions to apthe same manner, with like powers and authority, and subject point two to the same regulations and penalties, as are provided and contained in the several laws of this commonwealth relating to constables.
