CHAPTER C.

AN ACT

Authorising the administrators of William Pollock, deceased, to sell and : convey certain realestate therein mentioned.

CHAPTER CI.

A FURTHER SUPPLEMENT

To an act, entitled "An act to regulate the payment of costs on indictments.
