

CHAPTER CXLIX.

A FURTHER SUPPLEMENT

To an act, entitled "An act for laying out, making and keeping in repair the public roads and highways within this commonwealth, and for laying out private roads."

VIEWERS AND RE-VIEWERS AUTHORIZED TO ADMINISTER OATHS OR AFFIRMATIONS IN CERTAIN CASES.

SECT. 1. *BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That all viewers or re-viewers, whether for roads or sites of bridges, appointed by any court of quarter sessions, when met together for the purpose aforesaid, if a judge, alderman or justice of the peace cannot conveniently be had, then in that case any one of the viewers present shall administer an oath or affirmation to the other viewers that they will perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and fidelity.

MODE OF APPOINTING SUPERVISORS IN CASE OF CERTAIN VACANCIES.

SECT. 2. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That if at any time hereafter it may happen that no election should be held under the provisions of the second section of the act to which this is a further supplement, or in case of any irregularity in holding such elections for supervisors, it shall be the duty of the judges of the court of quarter sessions to appoint a proper person or persons to supply such deficiency, and such supervisor or supervisors so appointed shall have and exercise the same powers and authorities, and be liable to the same penalties as the supervisors elected in pursuance of the act to which this is a further supplement.
