

more than one thousand dollars, conditioned for the faithful and judicious application of all taxes and other monies which may come into their hands, and they are hereby required to apply the said monies as aforesaid between the first day of May and the first day of December in each year, which they are by law accountable in their official capacity, and for the paying over to their successors the balance that may be found due by them on settlement, which bonds shall be filed in the commissioners office of the respective county, and shall and may be sued out and recovered in the same manner, and under the same provisions as debts of a like amount are recoverable under the laws of this commonwealth.

CHAPTER CLXVII.

AN ACT

To extend for a limited time the act, entitled “ An act providing for the settlement of certain disputed titles to lands north and west of the rivers Ohio and Allegheny and Conawango creek, and also to continue in force for a limited time the act, entitled “ An act to encourage the warranting and patenting of lands north and west of the rivers Ohio and Allegheny and Conawango creek.”

SECT. 1. *BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That such parts of the act passed the twentieth day of March eighteen hundred and eleven, entitled “ An act providing for the settlement of certain disputed titles to land north and west of the rivers Ohio and Allegheny and Conawango creek,” as will expire on the first day of April next, be, and the same are hereby extended and continued until the first day of April eighteen hundred and nineteen.

SECT. 2. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That the act, entitled “ An act to encourage the war-

ranting and patenting of lands north and west of the rivers Ohio, Allegheny and Conawango creek," passed the first day of March one thousand eight hundred and eleven, shall be, and the same is hereby revived, re-enacted and continued in force to the first day of April one thousand eight hundred and nineteen. CHAPTER CLXVIII.

AN ACT

For the relief of sundry soldiers.

SECT. 1. *BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the State Treasurer be, and he is hereby directed to pay to Christian Pemberton of the city of Philadelphia, to Charles Kean of Washington county, to Adam Anderson of Westmoreland county, John Carey of Northampton county, William M. Gredy of Crawford county, and John Jemison of Butler county, severally forty dollars immediately and forty dollars annually during life, to be paid half yearly, to commence the first day of January one thousand eight hundred and eighteen to be paid to them or their order. Grant to certain persons of \$40, and an annuity of \$40 during life.

SECT. 2. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That the State Treasurer be, and he is hereby authorized and required to pay to the heirs or legal representatives of captain John Brady, late of Northumberland county, deceased, the sum of seven hundred and fifty dollars in lieu of a donation tract of land numbered one hundred and eighty two, situate within the triangular tract of land on lake Erie, formerly supposed to be in the tenth donation district, containing five hundred acres: *Provided,* That the heirs of the deceased release to the commonwealth all the right and title that they have or have had to the aforesaid five hundred acres of land at the time of passing this act, or at any time before the passage thereof. \$750 to be paid to captain John Brady in lieu of donation. Proviso.
