CHAPTER VIII.

AN ACT

To repeal the third section of "An act making further provision for the support of the Board of Wardens of* the port of Philadelphia."

SECT. 1. BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the third section of the act, entitled "An act making further provision for the support of the Board of Wardens for the port of Philadelphia," passed the twenty eighth day of February, one thousand eight hundred and sixteen, be, and the same hereby is repealed.

CHAPTER IX.

AN ACT

Authorising the Governor to appoint commissioners to lay out a state road from Waynesburg in Greene county, to intersect the Brownsville and Somerset turnpike road at or near Connellsville in Fayette county.

Sect. 1. BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the Governor be, and he is hereby authorised to governor to appoint three disinterested commissioners one of whom shall appoint three be a practical surveyor, to lay out and mark a state road commission-from the town of Waynesburg in Greene county, passing ers. through Uniontown, to intersect the Brownsville and Somerset turnpike road at or near Connelsville in the county of Fayette, the elevation of which road shall at no point exceed an angle of five degrees.
