

SECT. 20. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That if the said company shall not proceed to carry on the said work within ten years after the passing of this act, or shall not within fifteen years thereafter complete the said road, according to the true intent and meaning of this act, then in either of those cases all and singular the rights, privileges, liberties and franchises hereby granted to the said company, shall revert to this commonwealth.

CHAPTER XXI.

*AN ACT*

For the relief of Elizabeth Carmine

SECT. 1. *BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the State Treasurer be, and he is hereby required to pay to Elizabeth Carmine, of Bucks county, widow of William Carmine, a volunteer soldier in the late war, or her order, forty dollars immediately and forty dollars annually, to commence on the first day of January one thousand eight hundred and nineteen, and to continue during the term of five years: *Provided,* That upon the death or marriage of the said Elizabeth Carmine, the annuity hereby granted shall be paid to the guardian or guardians of the minor children of the said William Carmine, deceased.
