

CHAPTER XXX.

A SUPPLEMENT

To the act, entitled "An act to enable the Governor to incorporate a company for making an artificial road from Jersey Shore, in the county of Lycoming, to Coudersport in the county of Potter."

Number of shares reduced.

SECT. 1. *BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the number of shares required to be subscribed by the second section of the act to which this is a supplement, to entitle the subscribers to a charter of incorporation, shall be reduced to three hundred.

State subscription payable on the completion of sections of 5 miles.

SECT. 2. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That the president, managers and company of the Lycoming and Potter turnpike road, shall upon the completion of any five miles of said road, be entitled to such proportion of the sum authorised to be subscribed by the Governor, by the twenty-fourth section of an act of Assembly, entitled "An act making appropriations for certain internal improvements," passed the twenty-fourth of March eighteen hundred and seventeen, as five miles bear to the whole length of said turnpike road.

CHAPTER XXXII.

AN ACT

To prevent the imprisonment of females for debt.

SECT. 1. *BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Repre-*

 by reason of any debt contracted after the passing of this act.
